All proceeds will benefit Lake Country Area charities





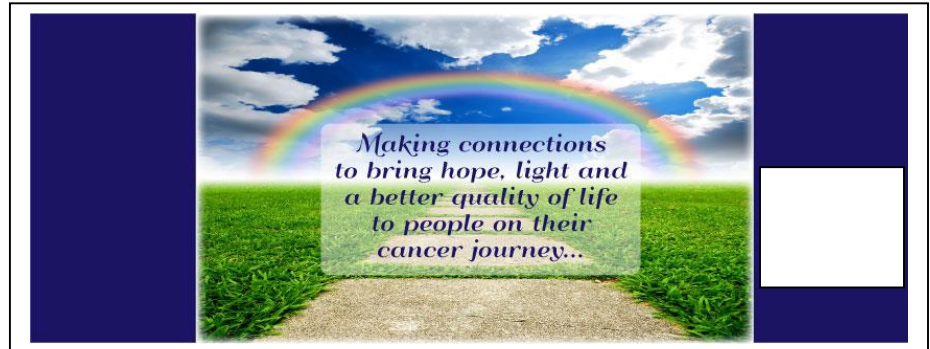

Awarding scholarships is a big portion of our mission at LCWC . We raise funds throughout the year and look forward to giving money back. Each year, we donate about an equal amount to Charity groups and to Scholarship recipients. Consider joining us as we review the many qualified applicants this year.

Everyone in the Lake Country Women's club is welcome to assist with the scholarship review process.

The review meetings consist of reading the essays out loud and evaluating them thru discussion. We then assign them a "value" Each is then combined with all the other "values" that are given for service hours, work experience, grades, etc, Rating them in this way tends to shake out the cream of the crop. We decide how much each scholarship will be- based on how many total candidates we select. It is helpful to be able to attend all the reading sessions, but not necessary.
